

Emergencies:
Although we hope emergencies do not happen, the truth is that severe weather or fire can occur at any time. If either instance were to occur, we ask that you do not come to the Nursery to pick up your child. Rather, it is safer to meet them in the following designated locations.

Fire:
The main church sign in the front of the church, near county road PPP.

Tornado:
The women 's bathroom next to the Fellowship Hall
Other Emergency Situation: Kids may be moved to Room 103 (immediately next store to the Nursery).

WEE CARE STAFF

The Wee Care Nursery is staffed by loving individuals that are excited to care for your kids while you are in worship, study or volunteering.

AGES

The Nursery is open to children birth to age 4. When Sunday School is in session (during the 9:15 service of the school year), children are encouraged to attend Sunday School in the 300 wing.

AVAILABILITY

The Nursery is staffed on Sunday mornings from 9am-Noon* and Wednesdays from 5:45-7:45pm. Though it is only staffed from 9am-Noon, for the 7:45am service the Nursery is open and worship is broadcast on the TV

REGISTRATION/SIGN-IN

Beginning each school year you will fill out a Parent Contact Information Card. The information on this card includes allergies and your cell phone number (which we will use to page you if we need you to return to the nursery). Please keep us informed of any changes. The reverse side of this card will be used to sign your child in and out of the nursery. When you "Initial In" your child's card will be moved to the "In Box." When you "Initial Out" your child's card will be moved to the "Out Box."

NURSING YOUR BABY

The Wee Care Nursing is open for any mothers who need to nurse their babies. There are rocking chairs for your comfort along with a television broadcasting the worship service. You can come spend time with your child while still being able to worship with the congregation.



WHAT TO BRING

We ask that you bring a diaper bag with your child's name clearly marked. Please leave your bags in one of the cubbies immediately outside of the nursery. It is not necessary to bring toys unless your child is comforted by a particular toy. In such a case, please share with your child that other children may wish to play with their toy as well and they will need to consider sharing.

LEAVING YOUR CHILD/CRYING/TEXTING

Your kids love you! They miss you when you're gone. They may be nervous or cry. Our nursery team is prepared to handle these situations. In most situations our team will be able to connect with your child and help him/her to calm down. Based on experience, this is easiest to do if parents simply leave. However, we always want to respect you as parents, so please communicate with us - even if it is a visual cue! If after leaving we determine that it is in the child's best interest for you to return we will text you. Please keep your phone on vibrate in case this is necessary.

DISCIPLINE

The goal of the Nursery staff is to provide a safe and caring environment for children without disruptive behavioral issues. To ensure this atmosphere, there may be times where a child will need to be directed away from the situation that triggers the behavior. This is done by gently explaining the incorrect behavior and introducing them to a different area of play away from the situation. If the behavior continues an age appropriate time out period, one minute for each age year of the child, will be applied. If the behavior still continues the parent will be requested to come back to the Nursery for their child. The staff will also contact parents immediately if their child engages in any inappropriate physical acts against another child. Any inappropriate behaviors at any time will be shared with the parent as communication is important between the staff, parent and child.
