Sermon Text: Isaiah 50:4-11

Questions:

1. Since Jesus was the Son of God, why did he bother with the Bible? Why would he have any need for the Bible?
2. What are some instances where Jesus quoted the Bible and what do those examples teach us?
3. In Isaiah 50, the Servant suffers at the hands of his enemies not because he is bad, but because he is good. What does this tell us about what we should expect in our own Christian lives?
4. How can we be soaked in the Bible?
5. What is the connection between Isaiah 50 and Romans 8?
6. What does Romans 8 teach us about God's love for us and our future vindication?
