
Tim Keller on Tithing:

"The acid test to know whether you have been humbled in your pride is what you do with your money. You may say, 'Oh yes, I believe everything is from God! It's all a gift!' But are you generous with your money? Or do you act as if it's all yours, you earned it?"

"People over the years have told me that the biblical idea of tithing is unreasonable. What if you turned to someone and said, 'I'm in trouble. I need a loan.' That person says, 'How much?' And you respond, "\$10,000. I'll pay it all back." The person responds, 'I'll tell you what, here is \$10,000, and all I want back is a \$1000, the rest is a gift.' How would you respond? What would you say? Would you say, 'How unreasonable! Unbelievable! You want \$1000 back on this loan! Who do you think I am?' But God says to you, 'Give away 10% of your money to the people around you.' And you say, 'That's unreasonable.' That proves in your own heart that you believe you are your own author. That proves that you haven't really seen yourself as a sinner saved by grace so that everything is a gift, including the area of money. Until you see that you are not in charge of your life, that you are not your own author, you will never see that He is your true author."


