## Did you know...?

The Book of Psalms is sort of the hymnal of the ancient Jews. The 150 Psalms are organized in 5 sections, each ending in a 'doxology,' a song or hymn of praise. The English word for it comes from the Greek *psalmoi* (ψαλμοί), which means instrumental music and refers to the words "accompanying" the music.
