The Hallelujah Hooligans are a fun-loving Christian music group from the Sioux Falls/Baltic, South Dakota area who have spent more than 20 years sharing their love of God through music, laughter, and fellowship. Trudy Hartman serves as a band leader and main contact person of the group.

How did they come up with their group name? They chose "Hallelujah" because they love to sing praise and make a joyful noise for God.
