



# Print and Fold Instructions


1. Set printer for 2-sided printing.



### WHO CARES?




- If the Bible’s account of a worldwide flood is true, the memory of this event would have been passed down through the descendants of Noah and across the whole face of the earth as it was repopulated.
- The ancient Greek hero was told to build a ark because the god Zeus wished to destroy humanity.
- The Aztec story of a universal flood says it took place 1,716 years after the creation of the world - almost the same as the Bible’s date!
- The Babylonian flood shares seven major details with the Bible’s account.
- Similar stories are found in Australia, India, Scandinavia, and China.
- And stories from the flood account that took place on sand dunes, in mountains, in swamps, in deserts, and in forests are found in almost every culture in the world.
- The cross-cultural universality of the flood account based on an event that took place in the Bible cannot be explained unless they are based on an event that took place in the Bible.

## WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Based on words from the Creator's own book, the Bible:

- God's original design for mankind was disrupted by sin (lying, lust, hate, gossip, etc.)
  - Romans 3:23 "For all have sinned [disobeyed God], and come short of the glory [beautiful perfection] of God." "All" means EVERYBODY. You, me, the pope - you name it. Nobody's perfect.
- Sin = judgment, death, and separation from God. Jesus = mercy, life, and relationship with God!
  - Romans 6:23 "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."
  - Romans 5:8 "But God commends his love toward us in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."

## HOW CAN JESUS HELP?

Let's see what the Bible says about that, too!

- 1 Peter 3:18 "For Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, indeed being put to death in the flesh but made alive in the Spirit."
- Acts 4:12 "And there is salvation in no other One; for there is no other name under Heaven given among men by which we must be saved."
- John 14:6 "Jesus said to him, I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life; no one comes to the Father, but by me."

Jesus isn't just one way you can be saved, He is THE way! You can't earn your way into heaven either - it's WHO you know that gets you in. You need Him like a fish needs water. He's the thing you've been looking for all your life.

**Romans 10:9 "If you confess the Lord Jesus, and believe in your heart that God has raised him from the dead, you shall be saved."**

### Why not try talking to Jesus now?

*He loves you. He's here with you. He's listening.*
