

PASTOR'S PONDERING

Are you a fundamentalist? I know that's a loaded word, but if we're honest, everyone is a fundamentalist about something. Think about the person who goes to the gym every morning at 6 a.m. They are a fundamentalist about health. Or how about the person who waits 20 plus minutes for a venti caramel crunch Frappuccino with extra whip, extra drizzle, and a scoop of almond milk? That's a fundamentalist about their coffee.

MUSICAL NOTES



John Newton (1725 – 1807), the author of the hymn, "Amazing Grace," was influenced by his mother who devoted herself to nurturing his soul. She died when he was seven, so he alternated between boarding school and the high seas. He served in the British navy, deserted, was captured and was flogged. More voyages, dangers, toils, and snares followed. But on the night of March 9, 1748, John was at sea in a brutal storm and cried to the Lord, and he said that the Lord came from on high and delivered him out of deep waters.

The next several years saw slow, halting spiritual growth in John, and in the end, he became one of the most powerful evangelical preachers in British history and the author of hundreds of hymns.

The original title for "Amazing Grace" was "Faith's Review and Expectation." It is based on Newton's study of 1 Chronicles 17:16-17. And the verse that wasn't included in the hymnal, but added in "My Chains Are Gone," is

*The earth shall soon dissolve like snow, the sun forbear to shine;
But God, Who called me here below, shall be forever mine.*

This information comes from *Then Sings My Soul* by Robert J. Morgan, published in 2011 by W Publishing. It contains 150 stories of some of the greatest hymns. I'd be happy to share it with you sometimes.
