Moses read the Law and sprinkled the people with blood

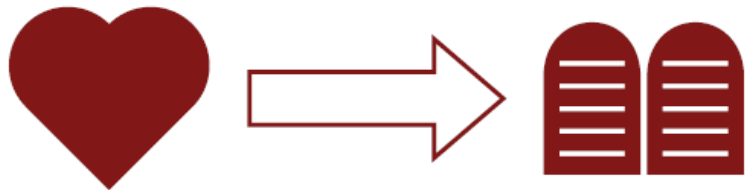
Jesus paid the Blood Price

our HEARTS

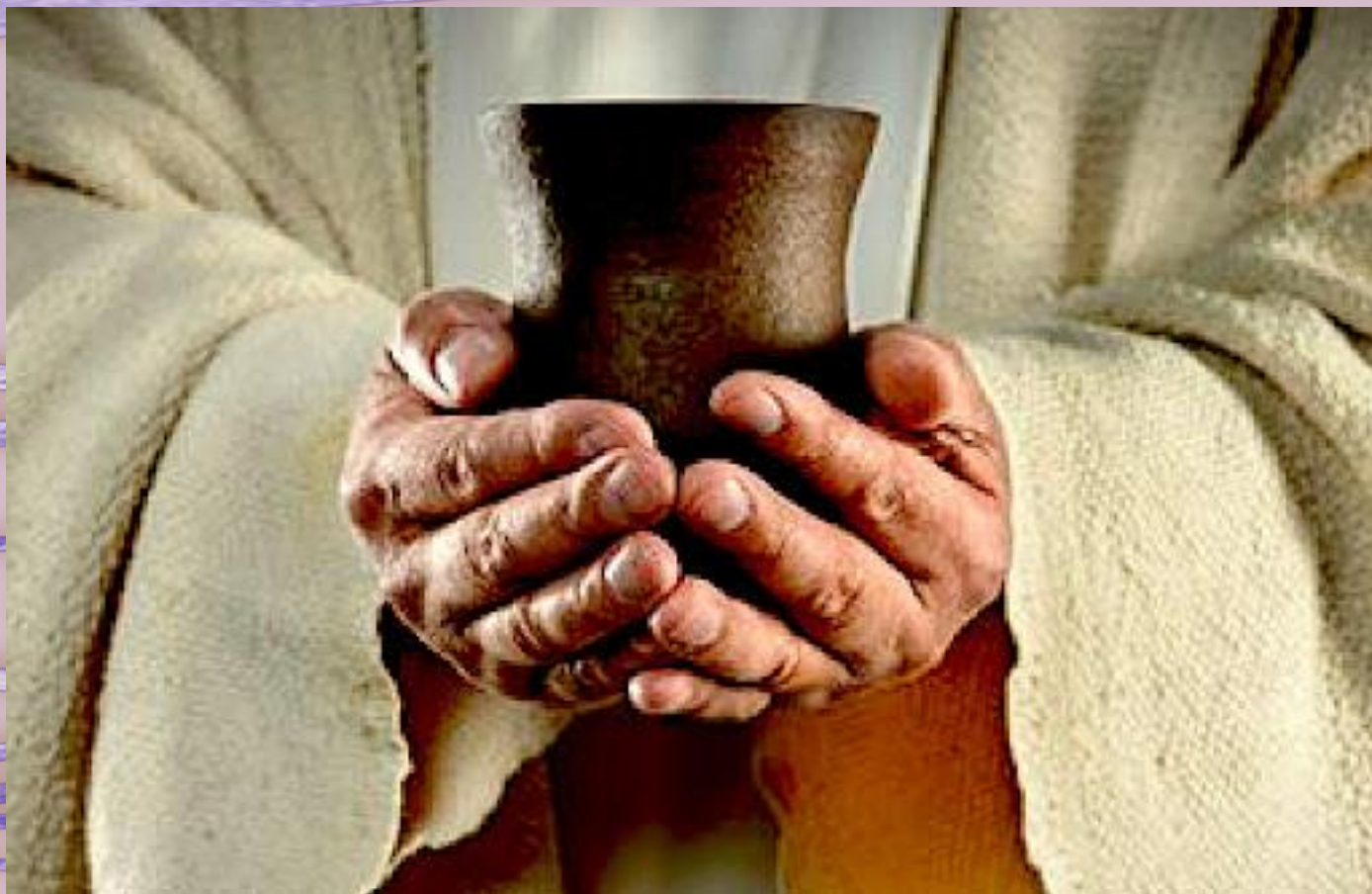
Symbolism of Bread and Wine

Item	Old Covenant	New Covenant
Bread	Suffering of Slavery	Christ's Physical Suffering for us (His Body)
Bread	Haste of leaving Egypt	Resting in God's Grace
Cup - Wine	Blood of Passover	Christ's Blood as payment for sin
Cup – Wine	Sealing of the Old Covenant	Christ's Blood sealing the New Covenant
