Mathew 22:37-39 (NLT) - *“You must love the LORD your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.’ This is the first and greatest commandment. A second is equally important: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’”*

Learning #1: Love is a choice, not a feeling.

1 Corinthians 13:4-8 (NIV) - *Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails.*

Colossians 3:14 (NLT) - *Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds us all together in perfect harmony.*

Learning #2: With relationships, come troubles.

1 Corinthians 7:28 (NLT) - *But if you do get married, it is not a sin. And if a young woman gets married, it is not a sin. However, those who get married at this time will have troubles...*

1 John 3:18 (NLT) - *Dear children, let’s not merely say that we love each other; let us show the truth by our actions.*

Learning #3: Love looks to give, not to get.

Ephesians 5:21 (NLT) - *And further, submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.*

Revelation 21:5 (NLT) - *Behold, I am making all things new.*
