Learning #1: Sometimes we start doubting God when life doesn't match our expectations.

Psalm 77:1-3 (NLT) - *I cry out to God; yes, I shout. Oh, that God would listen to me! When I was in deep trouble, I searched for the Lord. All night long I prayed, with hands lifted toward heaven, but my soul was not comforted. I think of God, and I moan, overwhelmed with longing for his help.*

Learning #2: The God who exists only to serve our plans doesn't exist.

Exodus 3:14 (NLT) - *God replied to Moses, "I am who I am.*

Isaiah 29:16 (NIV) - *You turn things upside down, as if the potter were thought to be like the clay! Shall what is formed say to the one who formed it, "You did not make me"? Can the pot say to the potter, "You know nothing"?*

Learning #3: We don't have to understand God's plan to trust God's character.

Isaiah 55:8-9 (NLT) - *"My thoughts are nothing like your thoughts," says the Lord. "And my ways are far beyond anything you could imagine. For just as the heavens are higher than the earth, so my ways are higher than your ways and my thoughts higher than your thoughts."*

Learning #4: When we believe God is in control, we can experience peace even when life doesn't meet our expectations.

Romans 8:28-29 (NLT) - And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them. For God knew his people in advance, and he chose them to become like his Son, so that his Son would be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters.

Psalm 23:4 (NLT) - Even when I walk through the darkest valley, I will not be afraid, for you are close beside me.
