Further Reflection for 11/09

1. When was a time someone served you in a way that made you feel uncomfortable? Why do you think it felt that way?
2. Who comes to mind when you think of someone who models a servant's heart? What stands out about them?
3. In Matthew 20:26-28, Jesus said, "*Whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant.*" What does that kind of greatness look like in everyday life?
4. Read **John 13:1-17**. What jumps out to you from the text?
5. How does knowing that "Jesus had all power" (John 13:3) change the way you see His act of service?
6. What might be holding you back from serving others right now — time, pride, fear, inconvenience, something else?
7. Think about your own "position of power" — at work, home, school, or church. How could you use that position to serve someone this week?
8. Pray for eyes to see opportunities to serve and the humility to act.
