Further Reflection on 5/17

1. Read Matthew 7:1-6 in both the NIV and the Message translations. You can find free access to view Scripture in different translations on biblegateway.com. After reading both translations, what stands out to you from the passage?
2. Pastor Sarah talked about first impressions and how they really are just snap judgments, what are some wrong first impressions you have had of certain people?
3. How do you feel about the idea that God tells us we shouldn't have hierarchies of sins, or in other words some sins are worse than others? Does that make you look inwardly at your own life differently?
4. Judging comes out of a place of self-righteousness and superiority. Think of an example in your own life where you or someone you know has judged someone and how that made the person who was judged feel.
5. Good discernment comes from a place of self-discipline and humility. How can you talk about what you have discerned as right or wrong in a way that is humble and not prideful?
6. Think about a subject within Christianity that may be inappropriate to share to someone who doesn't believe.
7. Think about a time or place where it might be inappropriate to share parts of Christianity.
