and forgetting to abide in Your grace.**

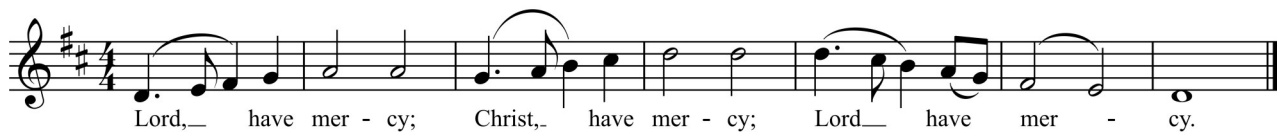
**We hold tightly to what we have, afraid there will not be enough,
