September 2026 - The Wisdom of God

The book of Ecclesiastes, written by Solomon, shares *wisdom* with its readers to avoid the vanity of earthly pursuits, in that, apart from God, life is indeed meaningless. Whether we are pursuing pleasure or possessions or fame or fortune, it is empty without Him. So, we must pursue God above all, trust His timing in all things, and follow His commands, “for this is the whole duty of man.” According to the book of Proverbs (also written by Solomon), wisdom has existed from eternity past with God, and just like wisdom, the love of God is part of His very nature. The book of The Song of Solomon describes the love between a bride and her groom. This is symbolic of the love of God for His people. In Hebrews 1:3, it reveals Jesus as the “exact representation of [God’s] nature.” We must pursue this Christlike love and wisdom in order to be who God has called us to be. The book of Mark is the shortest Gospel but still gives a full picture of the life of Jesus, His ministry and teaching, and His death and resurrection. We gain wisdom and become more loving when we study God’s Word and live like Jesus.
