What do people usually wear to church? Whatever's comfortable for you, from jeans to dresses to casual – you'll fit right in!

Is your congregation welcoming of LGBTQ+ people? Yes. We welcome all persons, inclusive of race, ethnic background, gender identity, sexual orientation, capability or circumstances of life.

When do you serve communion and how? Communion is usually served on the first Sunday of the month as well as in Christmas and Easter. God's table welcomes all. We use grape juice for communion so those in recovery can participate worry-free. Gluten free options are available.

How does baptism work at St Francis United Methodist? We recognize other denominations' versions of baptism and we baptize all ages – infants, youth, and adults.
