Those interested in serving on the Leadership Board will be scheduled for discernment conversations with the pastor and members of the Nominations Committee.

The Leadership Board is responsible for guiding and championing the mission, vision, values, and goals of CCUM. The Leadership Board holds all responsibilities of the administrative roles defined in the 2020/2024 United Methodist Book of Discipline (SPRC, Trustees, Covenant Council, and Finance), with a focus on governance through stewardship, strategic alignment, and accountable leadership. The Board will meet approximately 10 to 12 times a year, including an annual training retreat.

Qualifications of Board Members:

- Mature disciples committed to CCUM by their prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness
- Flexibility and cooperation
- Healthy communication skills
- Ability to maintain confidentiality

Requirements for Board Members:

- Attend annual Leadership Board training in the fall
- Ability to make a 1–3-year commitment on the inaugural Leadership Board
- Come to meetings prepared, having reviewed and read all packet information and reports
- Be an advocate, encourager, supporter, and carrier of the mission and vision of Christ Church
