

Higher Purpose Church – 5-Day Devotional

Pay the Price to Possess the Prize

This devotional is designed to help you move from **revelation to response** as you reflect on what it means to fully pursue the Kingdom of God. Each day builds on the message and invites you to see the value, confront fear, and embrace surrender.

Day 1 – Seeing the Value of the Kingdom

Scripture: Matthew 13:44–46

Jesus describes the Kingdom as treasure and a pearl of great price. In both parables, the turning point is not sacrifice—it's **revelation**. Once the men see the value, surrender becomes logical.

Many people struggle with commitment not because they don't love God, but because they haven't fully seen what the Kingdom offers. Revelation always precedes transformation.

Reflect:

What do you truly believe the Kingdom of God offers your life right now?

Pray:

Lord, open my eyes to see the true value of Your Kingdom. Help me recognize what others overlook.

Action Step:

Spend 10 minutes today reading Scripture slowly, asking God to reveal His Kingdom perspective.

Day 2 – From Comfort to Calling

Scripture: Hebrews 11:1, 6

Faith always involves risk. Both men in Jesus' parables had to leave what was familiar to gain what was greater. Comfort feels safe, but it often keeps us from growth.

The Kingdom calls us to trust God with what we cannot fully see yet. Faith isn't reckless—it's rooted in confidence that God's future is better than our present.

Reflect:

What area of your life feels "comfortable" but may be limiting your growth?

Pray:

God, give me the courage to step out of comfort and trust You with my future.

Action Step:

Identify one habit or routine God may be asking you to re-evaluate.

Day 3 – The Price of Surrender

Scripture: Luke 9:23–25

Jesus is clear: the Kingdom costs us our lives—but what we gain is far greater. Surrender is not punishment; it's alignment. Partial surrender keeps us in control, but full surrender puts God in charge.

There is no worship without sacrifice. What we release makes room for what God wants to give.

Reflect:

What are you holding onto that competes with God's lordship?

Pray:

Jesus, I surrender my will, my plans, and my priorities to You.

Action Step:

Write down one thing God may be asking you to release—and offer it to Him today.

Day 4 – Investing for Eternal Return

Scripture: Matthew 6:19–21

The Kingdom operates on a different value system. What looks costly in the moment often proves priceless over time. Like a wise investor, Kingdom citizens look beyond surface conditions to long-term return.

When we invest in God's Kingdom, we gain access to His provision, peace, and power—now and for eternity.

Reflect:

Where are you currently investing your time, energy, and focus?

Pray:

Father, help me invest my life in what matters eternally.

Action Step:

Choose one intentional Kingdom investment today (serving, giving, encouraging someone).

Day 5 – Joy on the Other Side of Obedience

Scripture: Philippians 3:7-8

The men in the parables didn't walk away grieving—they walked away with joy. When revelation is clear, sacrifice no longer feels like loss.

Fear often delays obedience, but obedience always leads to life. The Kingdom is still a deal—and it's worth everything.

Reflect:

How has fear shaped your decisions, and what might joy look like on the other side of obedience?

Pray:

God, replace my fear with faith and my hesitation with joy.

Action Step:

Take one step of obedience today—even if it feels small.

Closing Thought

You don't pay the price because you're fearless—you pay it because you've seen the value.
