



**JESUS TAUGHT ABOUT THE KINGDOM**  
Matthew 13; Mark 4

Jesus told the crowd, “God’s kingdom is like a man who planted good wheat seeds in his field. But while he slept, an enemy came and planted weeds. When the plants grew, the servants saw both wheat and weeds. They asked the man if they should pull the weeds out, but the man said, ‘No. Wait until harvest. Then I will have the wheat gathered and the weeds burned.’”

Jesus told more stories, saying: “God’s kingdom is like a mustard seed—the tiniest of all seeds. But it grows into the largest garden plant.”

Jesus said, “God’s kingdom is like treasure buried in a field. A man found it, hid it again, and joyfully sold everything he had to buy that field.”

Jesus also said God's kingdom is like a valuable pearl that a merchant was searching for. The merchant sold everything he had to buy it.

Jesus said that God's kingdom is like a net cast into the sea. It catches all kinds of fish, but later the good fish are kept and the bad ones thrown away."

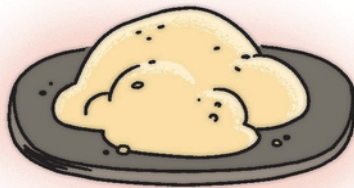
