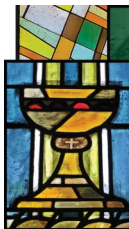

RCIA:

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is a process of faith sharing
and liturgical celebrations for those who are seeking full initiation
into the Catholic Church.

First Reconciliation & Communion/Confirmation:

Children wishing to receive these sacraments must attend the PRE
Program regularly for two years prior to special preparation for the
sacraments. Special Preparation for Reconciliation &
Communion is offered when a child reaches the age of seven (7)
(typically during the 2nd grade).

Confirmation Preparation is offered when child reaches age 14 and
9th grade.
