Children wishing to receive these sacraments must attend the PRE
Program regularly for two years prior to special preparation for the
sacraments. Special Preparation for Reconciliation &
Communion is offered when a child reaches the age of seven (7)
(typically during the 2nd grade).

Confirmation Preparation is offered when child reaches age 14 and
9th grade.

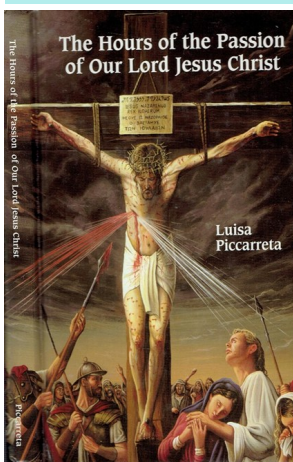

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence.

The law of fasting allows one full meal and two smaller ones. The law of abstinence prohibits the eating of meat. Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence in the U.S. The obligation of abstinence begins at age 14. The law of fasting obliges all between the ages of 18-59. Pastors and parents are to see to it that minors, though not bound by the law of fast and abstinence, are educated in the authentic sense of penance and encouraged to do acts of penance suitable to their age. All members of the Christian faithful are encouraged to do acts of penance and charity during the Lenten season.

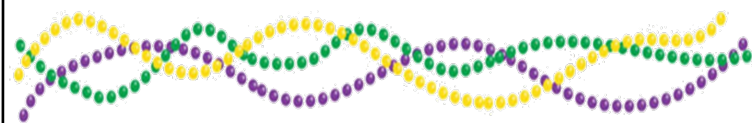

El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo son días de ayuno y abstinencia. La ley de ayuno permite una comida completa y dos pequeñas y prohíbe comer carne (pollo, res o puerco). Los viernes de Cuaresma son días de abstinencia en los EE.UU. La obligación de abstinencia comienza a la edad de 14 años. La ley de ayuno obliga a todos entre las edades de 18 y 59 años. Los pastores de la iglesia y los padres deben educar a los menores, aunque estos no estén sujetos a la ley de ayuno y abstinencia, sobre el auténtico sentido de la penitencia y alentarlos a hacer actos de penitencia adecuados para su edad. Se les exhorta a todos los Fieles Cristianos a hacer actos de penitencia y caridad durante la Estación de Cuaresma más allá de lo prescrito por la Ley.
